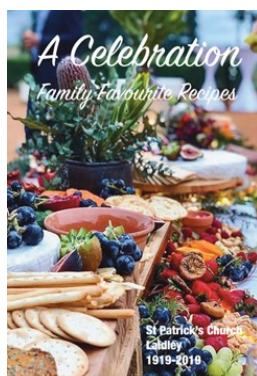

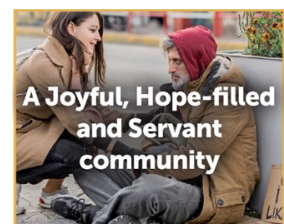

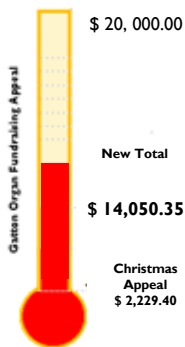
May we congratulate Father Noyichan on the wonderful work he has always done and continues to do for our Parish.
