Open the Eyes of my Heart, Lord!

John's Gospel is called the book of Signs. The purpose of signs in John's Gospel is to affirm that Jesus is the perfect revelation of God.

The story of healing the blind man tells us that the truth is something that evolves slowly, often involving struggle and doubt. Even though we have physical sight, if we are not careful we can be blind to truth, and consequently do a lot of harm to other people and the society. The Gospel invites us to **open our spiritual eyes** through an **inner spiritual journey** of prayer and spiritual exercises.

The inner spiritual journey **begins with silence** which takes a seeker to three levels of consciousness - mental, psychic and spiritual.

The mental level is the surface level where thoughts and feeling evolve like waves in the ocean. Here the mind objectifies everything, even the divine in the subject-object structure. All that we conceive about God and express through religious symbols and rituals are at this level of the mind.

The psychic level is controlled by sub-conscious factors which are shaped by one's own biography-repressed feelings, unexpressed thoughts, disturbing memories, and distracting thoughts.

The spiritual level is the deep-down inner faculty of introspection within us. It is like the inner light, the inner eye. All spiritual masters speak of this faculty of intuitive perception. When this inner light is kindled, when this inner eye is opened, one looks into the **sacred space within**. This is the divine abode, the inner temple, the cave of the heart, the garden of the soul. Referring to this Jesus said: *when you pray, first go into your inner room, close the door and therein meet God (Mt.6:6)*. When the inner eye is opened, one experiences one's true self and the divine SELF.

***"I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened,
