GOOD SHEPHERD SUNDAY (Year B)

21 April '24

"Journeying Through Lent: Reflections on Faith, Conversion, and Community"

Throughout the season of Lent, the Adult Faith Team led a transformative three-part series, guiding participants on a profound **journey of spiritual renewal**. Focused on the 90-day cycle of Lent, Easter, and Pentecost, the series emphasised the importance of **divine conversion and instigating lasting changes** through the practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving.

Each session served as a platform for genuine group discussions, allowing participants to delve deeply into their faith and personal experiences. The collective exploration fostered a sense of unity and shared spiritual growth among the community.

The culmination of the series took form in a deeply reflective Stations of the Cross session, where individuals were invited to contemplate the profound sacrifice of Christ and its relevance in their own lives. Through prayerful meditation and contemplation, participants were encouraged to embrace a deeper understanding of their faith and the **transformative power of Christ's love**.

Further enhancing their spiritual journey, parishioners engaged in a **Lenten Retreat** led by **Lisa McKerr** from Evangelisation Brisbane, focusing on **prayer**, and nurturing their **individual relationship with God**. This retreat served as a pivotal moment for introspection and spiritual renewal, empowering participants to deepen their connection with the divine and **discern their unique spiritual path**.

On **Friday April 26th**, at St Mary's Church Gatton, we have the first of four Parish **ENCOUNTER** nights scheduled across all our churches this year. These events will bring us together in **prayer**, **worship**, **reflection**, **and Eucharistic adoration**. We extend a warm **invitation for you** to join us—a chance for profound spiritual connection and meaningful prayerful contemplation.

CAN YOU HEAR HIS VOICE?

"I am the good shepherd...and I lay down my life for the sheep and they will heed my voice." - John 10:14-16

Many times, Jesus responds in quiet whispers that are not so obvious. We are encouraged to take time every day, in silence, to actively listen for His voice. His is the voice of LOVE, of ENCOURAGEMENT, of STRENGTH, of MERCY and of HOPE. He hears our prayers ... we listen for His response as He speaks and acts.

On this Good Shepherd Sunday, we are reminded of a homily by Pope Saint John Paul II, he said "Jesus has a specific task in life for each and every one of us. Each one of us is hand-picked, called by name by Jesus! There is no one among us who does not have a divine vocation! Some are called audibly by God, but the usual kind of call is internal, through the inner working of the Spirit."


