### "Christian prayer begins not with speaking but with listening; and learning to pray is therefore learning to listen – to listen even to the silences of Cod."

Archbishop Mark writes "Pope Francis has invited the whole Church to celebrate a Year of Prayer to prepare for next year's Jubilee. We are being called by the Successor of Peter to go deeper into the experience of **listening to God**, **speaking to God**, **being with God in silence**.

**Prayer is like breathing**: it's as necessary for our spiritual life, as breathing is for our physical life. Christian prayer begins with listening to the **God**, who never ceases to communicate with us. If all we do is speak, we will "babble like the pagans", as Jesus says in Matthew 6:7. But true prayer is like charging an iPhone; without it, the device simply doesn't work. Nor do we.

Prayer is the womb of more powerful mission, so there is more to this Year of Prayer than growth in piety. This is true for all the baptised since the **whole church is missionary**."

As a way into a deepening experience of prayer, Archbishop Mark offers a prayer that comes from his own listening to God. This prayer is available on a **prayer card** from this weekend – it includes a QR code that gives access to further resources to support you along the journey of prayer.

Let us pray ...

You speak, Lord God, even in silence and we listen with ears of the heart.

We listen and our eyes are opened to see all things as they are. We see with the eyes of Jesus and our mouths are opened to speak of our joy and our sorrow, to sing your praise and seek your help. This is the grace of prayer you give, that opens heaven to earth, heart speaking to heart.

Give us that grace in this Year of Prayer, teach us to pray anew, lead us deep into the heart of Jesus who is our prayer for ever and ever. Amen

## **HOLY WEEK CELEBRATIONS**

Our parish community came together in large numbers to celebrate the Triduum. Holy Thursday was such a sacred evening; the Word of God proclaimed, the symbolic washing of the feet as Jesus did, and celebration of the Holy Eucharist. Completing our night in silence and adoration, we left quietly to come together for Stations of the Cross on Friday morning.

At Gatton, the Stations were led through the eyes and heart of Mother Mary, feeling her pain, but knowing it had to be for our salvation. The commemoration of the **Passion of our Lord** at Laidley was profoundly moving – the powerful proclamation of the Gospel, the quiet reflective veneration of the Cross, left an imprint on your heart. At the **Easter Vigil**, **Amanda** and **Jeeahn** we received into full Communion with the Catholic Church, and **Jaxon** and **Jye** were Baptised, and **Todd** and **Kylie** receive all three Sacraments of Initiation – Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist.
